Superintendent's Update

Beautification Projects Moving Forward

I'm pleased to announce that the Board has approved moving forward with several of our planned beautification projects around the golf course. We will be focusing on improvements around the Pro Shop, the #5 tee area, and the intersection leaving #9 green.

We are planning to order the plant material in the middle of September and begin preparing the areas for installation. These projects will help improve the appearance of some of the

more visible areas of the course and, hopefully, add some character and curb appeal to the property. We are still looking for a few additional donations toward purchasing a nicer water cooler for the #5 tee area. If you are interested in helping with this project, please notify Helen. We will also be looking for volunteers to help clean up the existing beds and assist with planting the new material. More information will be provided as we get closer to the planting date. We appreciate any members who are willing to lend a hand and help us make these improvements happen.

Greens Update

We have also begun the healing process on our greens. With the better temperatures we have been experiencing lately, especially the cooler nighttime temperatures, we were able to move forward with seeding thin areas, topdressing, and fertilizing.

The greens are beginning to respond nicely, and we are encouraged by the progress we are seeing. Cooler nights give the Bentgrass a much better opportunity to recover and establish new growth. We will continue to focus on providing the greens with the conditions they need to recover while keeping them as playable as possible. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through the recovery process.

As always, the maintenance staff appreciates everyone's support as we continue working to improve the course and make Scotch Meadows the best it can be.

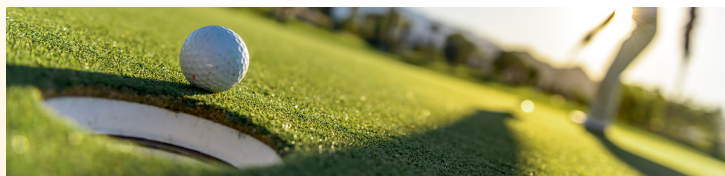
